Contact Grid

Background information

During the last TIPS-CG meeting the Eurosystem presented a procedure to be followed by PSPs in TIPS in order to receive contact details of other PSPs in case of operational issues.

TIPS-CG highlighted the benefit to have a list of contact details in hand before a specific need arises.

The TSWG was invited to discuss on:

- > the timing as of when the contact list can be used
- > whether the contact list that was created for the TIPS notification tool can be reused
- > the frequency of the update of such a potential contact list
- > if and how the contact details of Reachable Parties could be maintained





TSWG analysis and considerations



- GDPR risks in the event TIPS notification tool includes personal data, the list cannot be used.
- Impossibility to prepare a list including the contact details of Reachable Parties at the level of an NCB - non-existing contractual relationship between them.
- Contact details existing today in TARGET2 are not so frequently used by participants
- Such a need is broader than instant payments & other solutions already exist in the market that could be used to support TIPS participants.

Contact Grid

Proposed way forward to support the participants' needs

- The TSWG considers the initial solution proposed to be sufficient for now considering the constraints faced.
 - <u>Procedure</u>: PSP could request the contact of a counterparty for TIPS operational matters to their responsible NCB (NCB1):
 - Responsible NCB (NCB1) will contact the NCB (NCB2) of the counterparty in question
 - NCB2 will approach relevant participant to get the contact details*
- Usage of other market solutions in place (e.g. directory services)

Note: the proposed solution is only possible during the standard support hours of NCBs and only exchange of generic contact details upon an agreement of the PSP (i.e. no personal data).
